Day 1: Saturday, 12 October 2024

Venue: PARKROYAL on Beach Road

Diverse cases, including breast cytology and cases with molecular pathology correlation, with valuable learning points will be contributed by faculty and individually discussed, with sharing of key points and take aways. Case mix will replicate those encountered in daily practice.

Cases will be available for preview as whole slide digital images prior to the workshop.

Educational objectives:

- 1. To evaluate microscopy and cytology cases encountered in daily diagnostic breast pathology practice.
- 2. To be familiar with histological and cytological criteria for the diagnosis of common as well as unusual breast lesions.
- 3. To be aware of pitfalls and challenges in the pathology and cytology of various breast lesions.
- 4. To review the role of adjunctive tests, including molecular pathology, in achieving diagnoses.
- 5. To highlight issues in receptor interpretation in breast cancer, incorporating latest updates in HER2 classification.

Virtual microscopy and discussion of cases with Faculty: Topics include ~


Intraductal epithelial proliferations, papillary breast lesions, mucinous breast lesions, lobular lesions, apocrine lesions, spindle cell lesions, fibroepithelial lesions, unusual breast cancer types, adjunctive studies, and more, with a major emphasis on cytology and molecular pathology.

Apart from discussions around the cases, lectures will be integrated into the slide seminar to enrich the content:
